
AGGREGATE PRIZE

Renmark Horse and Pony Club are running a series of three competitions throughout 2015. There will be an aggregate prize presented at the final competition in August in five categories:

- ~Junior Dressage
- ~Senior Dressage
- ~Junior Show Jump
- ~Senior Show Jump
- ~Supreme High Point





The horse and rider combination with the most points in each category will be awarded with:

~1st - rug, sash and \$100 ~2nd - sash

The Supreme High Point winner well be awarded with a rug, sash and \$150.

A junior rider is under 17 years and a senior rider 17 years and over. A rider who starts at the beginning of the series as a junior and turns 17 during the year, must remain a junior for the duration of the series to be eligible for the aggregate on any horse. If they are not competing for the aggregate prize, they may ride as a senior after they turn 17 years.

Aggregate points are awarded to a horse/rider combination.

Aggregate prize winners are requested to be present at the final competition for sponsors to present prizes.

SHOW JUMPING

Course Builder - Len Riches Judge - Erica Riches 8.30am start

- 1. Rainbow Clear Round Stakes rail on the ground. Max 2 rounds. For riders not competing in any other show jump event other than event 2. Not eligible for the aggregate prize. \$3.00 entry fee per round. Ribbons only.
- 2. 45cm table AM3
- 60cm table AM3
- 4. 75cm table AM3
- 5. 90cm table AM3
- 100cm table AM3

Three events only per horse in show jumping.







DRESSAGE

Event 7 will commence at 8.30am followed by events 8 & 9. Tests to be ridden in a 60m x 20m arena.

- 7. EA Prelim test 1:3
- 8. EA Prelim test 1:2
- 9. EA Novice test 2:2
- 10. EA Novice test 2:3
- 11. EA Elementary test 3:2

Event 12 will commence at 10.00am followed by events 13 & 14. Tests to be ridden in a 40m x 20m arena.

- 12. Walk/trot test For riders not competing in any other dressage test other than event 13. Not eligible for the aggregate prize. \$3.00 entry per test. Ribbons only.
- 13. PCASA Grade 5 test 5B
- 14. PCASA Grade 4 test 4B

Three events only per horse in dressage.

Test may be called, but caller must abide by the rules.

- 15. Test 5B and 45cm
- 16. Test 4B and 60cm
- 17. Test 1:2 and 75cm
- 18. Test 1:3 and 90cm
- 19. Test 2:2 and 100cm



Three events only permitted for combined training. Scores will be used from the relevant individual dressage and show jumping events. For those competitors not wishing to compete in the individual dressage, they will be included in the relevant dressage draw.
